Ad Hoc Committee Update for Worship & Gatherings

The Ad Hoc Committee for Worship and Gatherings continues to meet as case numbers, hospitalizations, and deaths from COVID-19 maintain a downward trend in our area. The overall improvement is promising, and because of this, the committee has recommended a transition to in-person worship. Masks and physical distancing will be required, and those in high-risk categories are encouraged to continue watching worship via livestream unless they have been fully vaccinated.

Each week, starting **March** 1^{st} , the church office will email a sign-up list for up to 20 individuals to attend worship. Those without access to email can call the church office and leave a message, requesting to be added to the list. If no slots are available, those names will be carried forward to the next week. If the level of cases in Lee County rises significantly prior to the worship service, in-person attendance will be postponed. We will continue in this manner until the committee meets again on March 15th to review and make further recommendations.

The committee remains hopeful that case numbers will continue to improve, and this is the first step towards a larger scale return to gatherings at the church. We also remain grateful for the congregation's patience and resilience.
