On Easter, we dedicated a new communion table, which was designed and created for Auburn First Baptist through our Life is Calling initiative. Through the Life is Calling Committee, we have talked about our story as a congregation and how to share it with others. In addition to the communion table, Dale Peterson has written our *Preparation for the Table*, which we will use each time we celebrate communion. We have commissioned a VBS curriculum about calling, *Partners with God*, and we will use it this summer. We have added lighting to our courtyard and ordered picnic tables for this area. We have also created a logo for our projects for the Life is Calling initiative. We will continue to plan bridge events, like the Medical Debt Panel Discussion we hosted.

We will also dedicate a Peace Pole for the courtyard, which says, "May Peace Prevail on Earth," in eight different languages. We will reflect on the stories of our congregation about ministry and calling. We will plan events for our youth and college students. We hope all of these projects enrich the life of our congregation and enable us to lean into our story and to share it with others.
