

LIFE IS CALLING

In 2019, Auburn First Baptist received a \$30,000 grant from the Center for Congregational Resources at Samford University for participating in its Life is Calling Initiative, inviting churches in Alabama to reflect on their calling and to create projects associated with it. With this grant, we commissioned a custom built communion table for our sanctuary, created a graphic identity for "A Place at the Table," hosted a panel discussion on Medical Debt Forgiveness, and dedicated the Peace Pole in our Courtyard.

Recently, the Center for Congregational Resources invited Auburn First Baptist to participate in the next phase of its Life is Calling Initiative, which will allow the church to receive another grant to expand its projects for our "A Place at the Table: Building and Serving Community" initiatives. We are grateful to the members of the Life is Calling Committee, serving this year: Leah Duzy, Beth Smith, Ryan Thompson, Ronda West, and Mark Wilson.
